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How Does One Address and Justify Suppression and Evil

- O.K., so we are saying that the purpose of life is to gain expanded consciousness, and in order to do this we come to the University of Duality on Earth to learn lessons, and consequently raise our vibrational frequency and consciousness.
- And, we say, we are going to do this by adopting compassion and love, because love transmutes all negativities and low-chakra dissipative energy sources such as fear, anger, etc.
- We are also saying, that meanwhile, all these experiences are like nothing more than being in a game, the game being here is 'duality.'
- Although, the feelings of hurt, disappointment, and anger are quite real here, as our 5 sensory perceptions are most sophisticated, indeed, a work of scientific and technological marvel.
- From the point of view of higher dimensional consciousness, any attachment to our 3D sojourns are futile, especially the question of material possessions, no matter how hard we have worked for it, how much difficulties, pain, and discomfort we have endured, and how much of our own blood and tears we shed in order to urn and then preserve our belongings.
- When a ruthless oppressor, of our own specie, who is supposed to be bound by the same 'Divine Plane' and directives, comes along and pushes us to the max with utter predatory intent to plunder and deprived us from our hard earned real estates or possessions, what are we supposed to do?
- The feeling of anger associated with being subject to such victimization is beyond description and too much to bear.
- It is evil in flesh, and the lack of justice and betrayal is beyond measure.

- **At the same time:**
- **1. Victimization is a dirty word because victim consciousness is a well-established criterion of the higher dimensional consciousness; one that is taboo, self-degrading in terms of one's light quotient and vibrational frequency, and can be attributed to one thing only: lack of taking self-responsibility. And what if we have, indeed, done nothing but to work hard, honestly and diligently, and having had abided by the flawed predatory laws of 3D reality on Earth over, and over? Yet we have always swallowed the suppression, taken the tyrannies while transmuting our anger. What kind of responsibilities we are now supposed to take into consideration and feel ashamed of not having fulfilled?**
- **2. Attachment to material possessions are supposed to be futile from the point of view of higher consciousness as only the experiences we obtain in 3D duality are precious and all they count.**
- **3. We are not supposed to be judgmental whatsoever. So what shall we do with the oppressing predator? Do not judge him/her for his wrongdoings? Leave him/her to the All Mighty God? And, what happens then?**
- **4. God is non-judgmental. There is no 'Sin' or 'condemnation' or 'hell.'**
- **5. We are supposed to leave the tyrant oppressor to his/her wrongdoing and fate. And, what happens then? He will diminish his frequency and light quotient and is practically condemned to lower planes of consciousness eventually. Or, if we agree that 'judgment day' and 'condemnation' is out of question because God is benevolent and most merciful, his 'punishment' is stagnation and failure to achieve expanded consciousness, which is the very crux of our existence. And what exactly does this mean? He/she will be rejoining his/her Higher Self after this incarnation, and subsequently, reincarnate with the same identity or else and get into the game of duality again and again. - 7. And, how do you handle the anger of betrayal associated with extreme injustice?

Not only it resonates with the concept of expanded consciousness, its implications are resoundingly justified.
- 9. Obviously, forgiving and moving on to the higher planes of consciousness where such collective consciousness is in effect and is the 'norm' is both inspiring, and may be enthusiastically embraced.
- However, still two points remain:
 - (i) How do you handle the anger and what strategy you can take to fight the injustice prior to the point that it is all over and the damage is done and the tyranny is consummated?
 - (ii) How do you justify the action of the tyrant and the predatory oppressor after completion of the crime, especially when there does not seem to be

any principles in effect that would provide an answer or remedy for the problem of the aforementioned injustice at hand?

- **The validity of forgiveness aftermath the event of betrayal and the crime committed is not in question as there is absolutely no point in anger, hatred, and revenge afterwards.**
- **The said dilemma is associated with justification of the crime that is to be concluded and the resulting anger which is germinated from the very act of such oppression.**
